- ❑ In the maintenance department we continue to have two people who are in charge of providing adequate care to the property, the houses, the administrative building and the school. At the beginning of January, the construction of new desks and tables was completed for the use of the new students at school. A family dining room table is currently being built, for use during visits by missionary groups.
- ❑ During this time, this team is repairing walls due to the fungus that comes from humidity, at the same time painting the buildings on the outside to provide adequate care. Planting in the garden continues with corn, cilantro, radishes, cucumbers and mustard.
- ❑ Thank God we also have the security department, which continues to provide night-time surveillance of the entire property, from 7:00 pm to 6:00 am.
- ❑ Currently we have two employees to help in the houses. They help in cleaning the four houses, two days a week for each family and the remaining day they work in the administrative building and school.

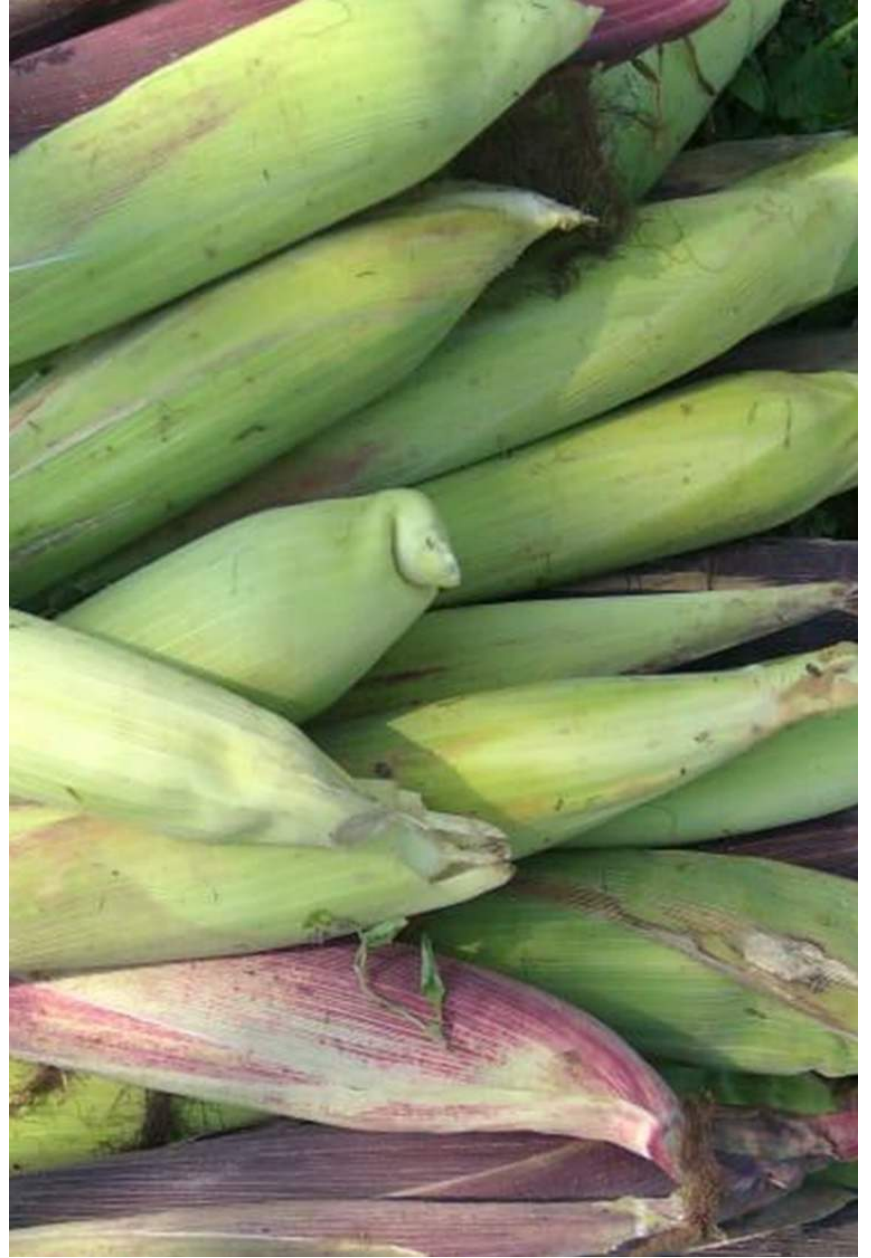






These are some fruits from the harvest in the garden, and work done by the maintenance team; chairs and tables for homeschool children.

Second Grade/Special Ed: Julia

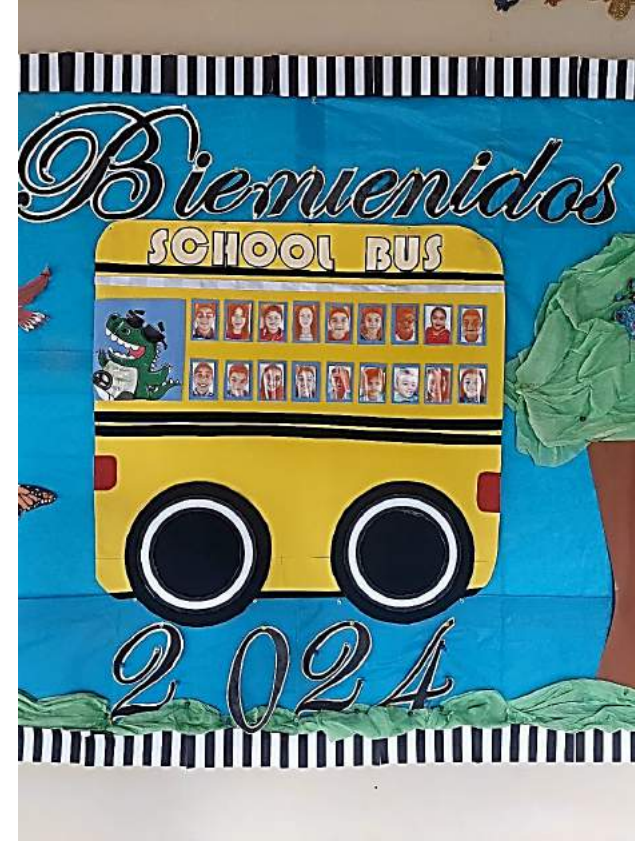
Third grade: Valentina, Angel, Jair, Emir, and Victor.

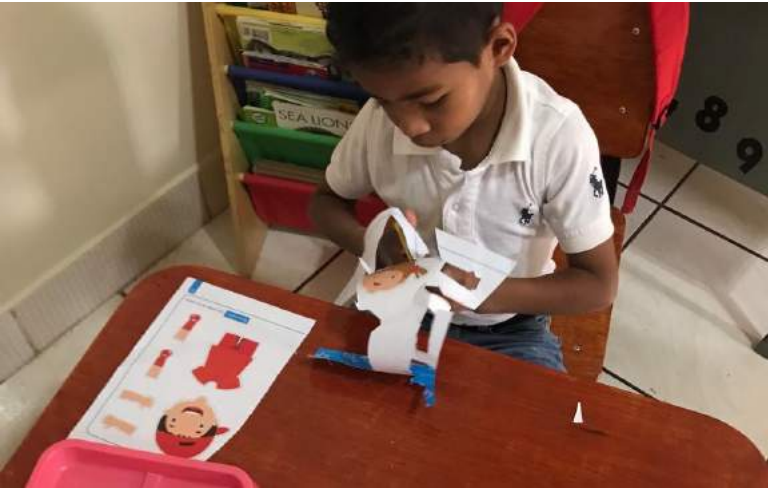




## VALUE OF FRIENDSHIP AND THE VALUE OF OBEDIENCE
